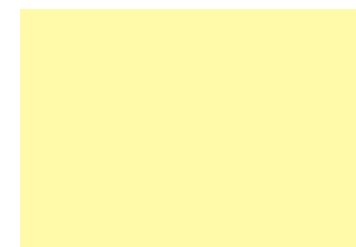

Promise is a suspension concentrate formulation for the correction of magnesium deficiency in a range of agricultural and horticultural crops.

HAZARD CLASSIFICATION: 6.4A

WARNING: This product should not be swallowed or inhaled. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes.

FIRST AID: If swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. If splashed in eyes, wash out immediately with water.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Avoid skin and eye contact and inhalation of spray mist. When mixing or applying wear waterproof gloves, eye protection, boots and overalls. DO NOT eat, drink or smoke while using. Wash splashes of concentrate from skin immediately. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and face thoroughly before meals and after work. Wash protective clothing daily after work.

STORAGE: Store in original container, tightly closed and in a dry, cool area away from direct sunlight and foodstuffs. Protect from frost, store above 5 °C.

SHELF LIFE: Very stable. Stores for at least 2 years from the date of manufacture in normal agricultural chemical storage conditions.

DISPOSAL: Triple rinse empty container and add rinsate to the spray tank. If recycling, replace cap and deliver clean container to an Agrecovery depot. Alternatively crush and bury in a suitable landfill. Dispose of product only by using according to the label, or at an approved landfill.

RECOMMENDED RATES OF APPLICATION:

Apply 4.0 litres/ha in at least 200 litres of water/ha. Repeat 10-14 days later if deficiency is severe. Do not apply more than 16 litres/ha per crop per season. Increase the water volume as necessary if foliage is dense or when applying to fruit trees.

TIMING OF APPLICATION:

Cereals: Any time from the 3-leaf stage. Repeat after 10-14 days if necessary. Wheats have shown quality improvements from a further application at GS39-59.

Potatoes: Apply as soon as there is enough foliage present to absorb the spray and repeat in a programme at 10-14 day intervals as part of a programme.

Sugar Beet, brassicas and other vegetables: Apply at the 6 leaf stage or as indicated by the results of tissue analysis. Repeat if required.

Top fruit: Apply up to 3 sprays commencing after petal fall at intervals of 21 days.

Best results will be obtained when Headland Promise is applied during the early morning or evening when moisture is present in the plant.

Do not apply in extremes of temperature, very bright sunlight or when the crop is under drought or other stress.

The addition of Headland Guard 2000 at 0.1% of water volume to improve spray retention and rainfastness is strongly recommended, particularly under hot or showery conditions.

MIXING AND APPLICATION:

Shake the container well before use. Fill the spray tank with half the required volume of water and begin agitation. Add the required amount of Headland Promise slowly to the tank, maintaining agitation. Add the remainder of the water, and apply without delay. Do not allow the diluted mixture to stand idle without agitation. Thoroughly clean the sprayer after use.
