### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Always add Multi-Film Extra to a partly filled spray tank so that the additive is mixed well with the spray solution.

Do not use Multi-Film Extra with selective weed killers unless recommended.

Multi-Film Extra spreader sticker is formulated specially to give increased wetting of plant foliage; more uniform distribution and coverage of the spray liquid; and better penetration of the surface of the foliage under dry conditions.

USE	RATE
<b>Total vegetation and non selective weed control</b>	25 ml of Multi-Film Extra to 100 litres of spray solution or 1 teaspoon of Multi-Film Extra to knapsack sprayer (15 litres).
<b>Horticultural use</b>	25 ml of Multi-Film Extra per 100 litres of spray with appropriate insecticides and fungicides.
<b>Aerial Application</b>	80 ml of Multi-Film Extra to 100 litres of spray solution.

**RATES OF APPLICATION:** Dilution rates for Multi-Film Extra may vary according to the hardness of the water in different localities. The object is to use sufficient additive to give uniform coverage by the spray droplets but excessive rates may lead to undesirable foaming and unnecessary run-off.
